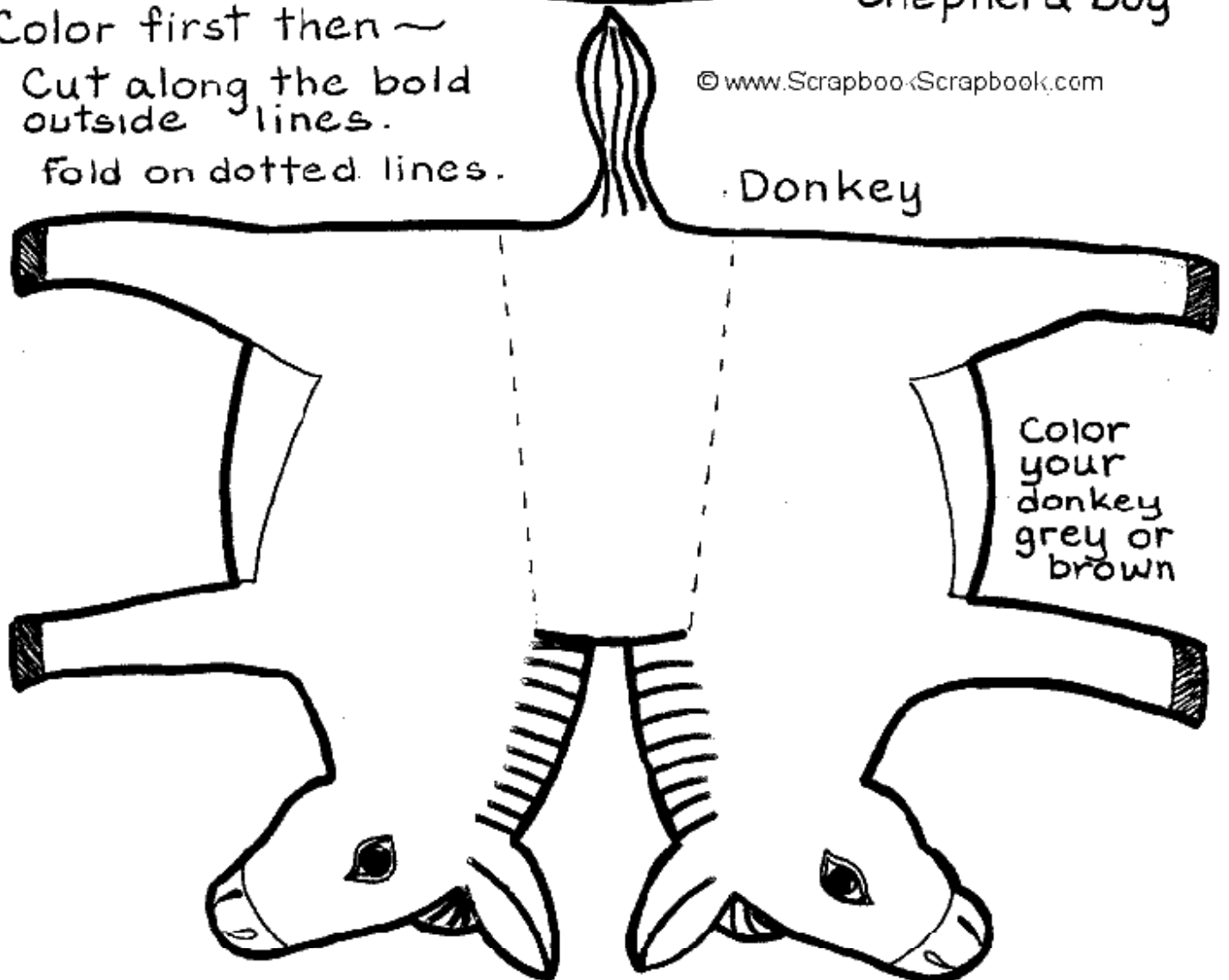

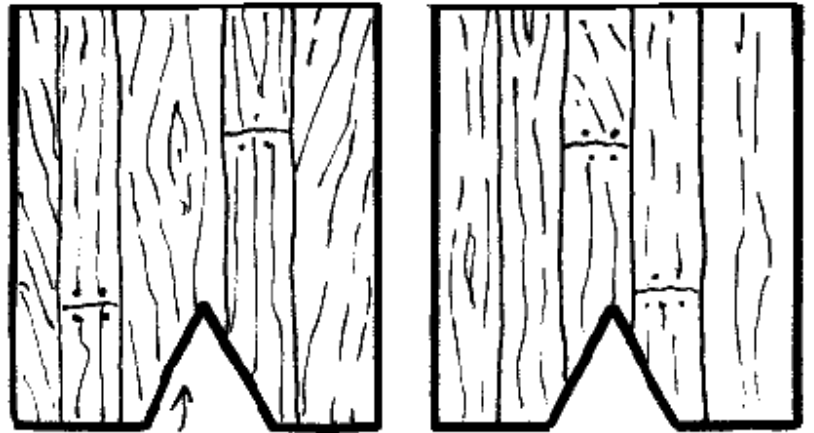

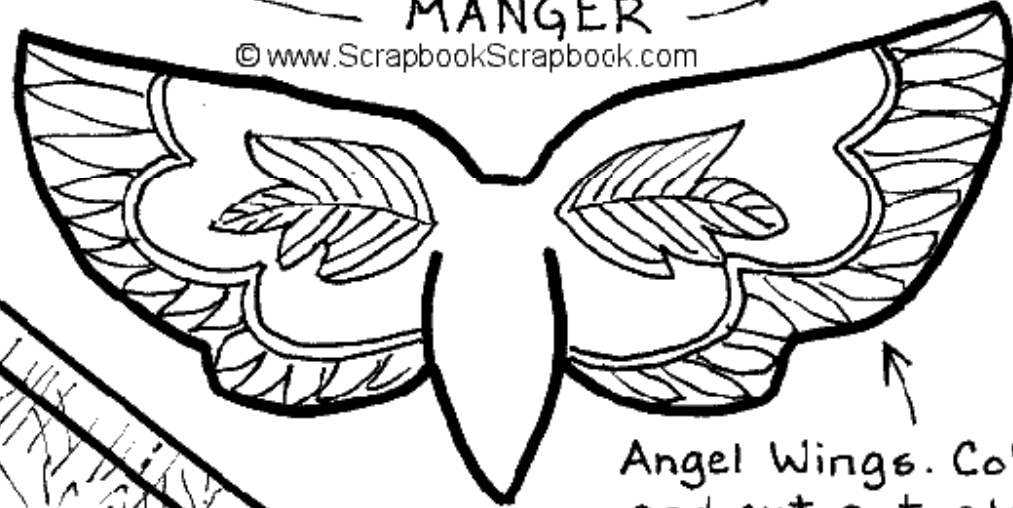
Slide manger crib slits over the legs

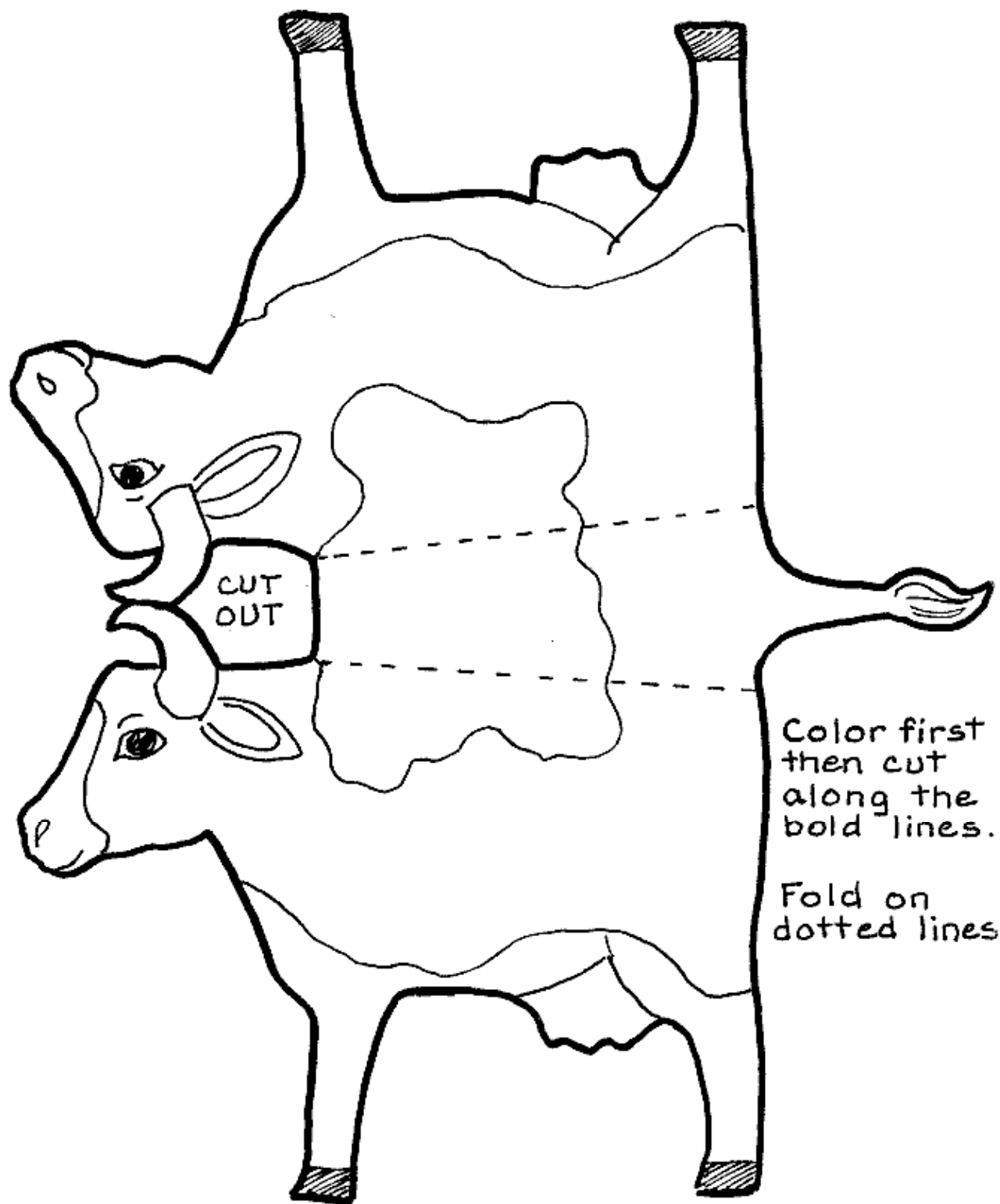
Angel Wings. Color and cut out along the bold outlines. Slip the wings into the back of glued Angel.

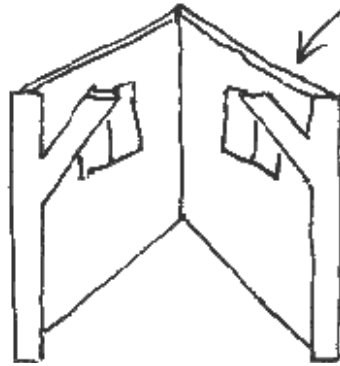
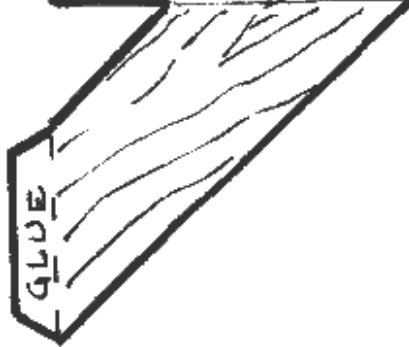
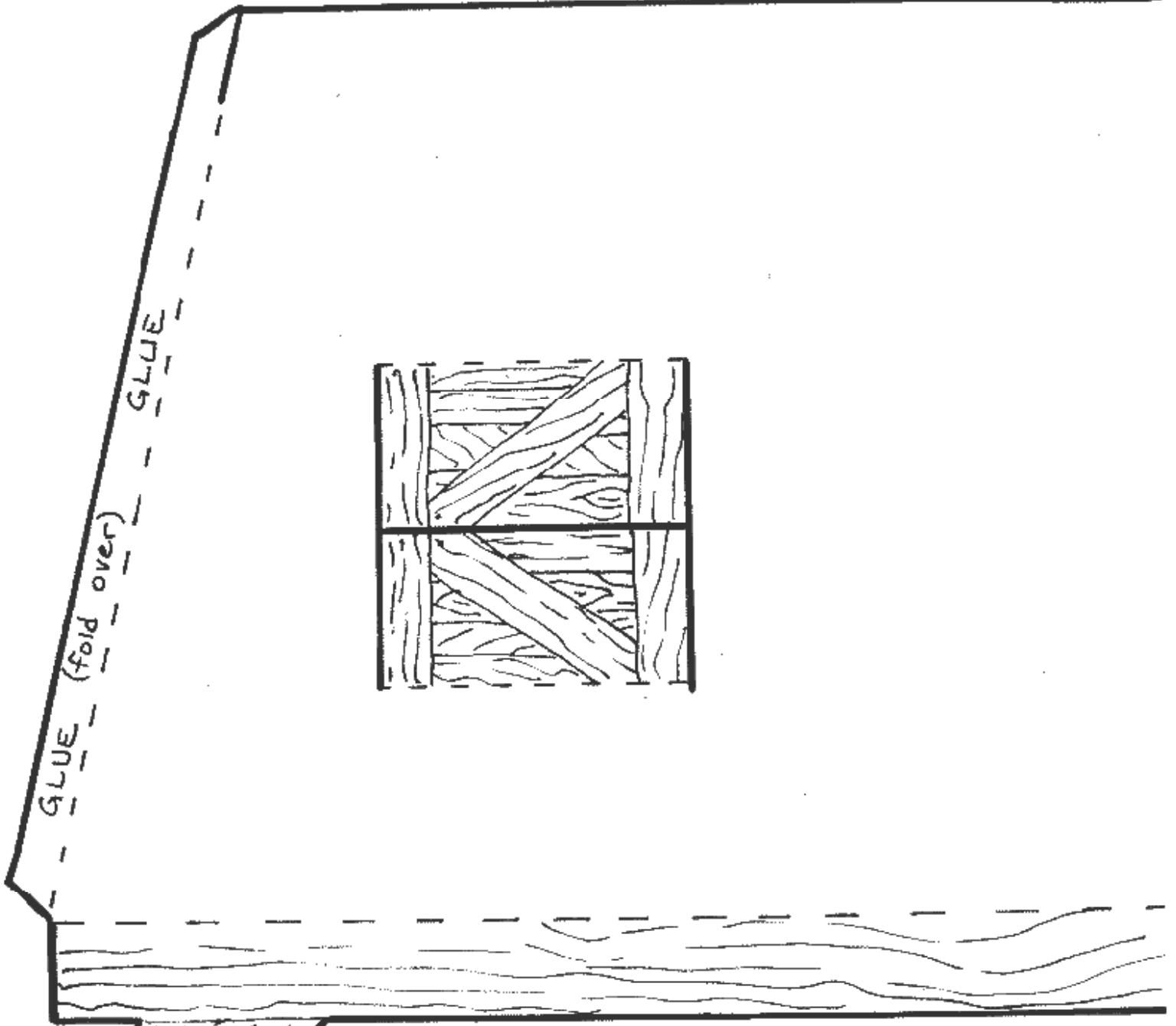


The STAR.
Color gold or yellow and cut out along the bold lines. Glue to stable roof.



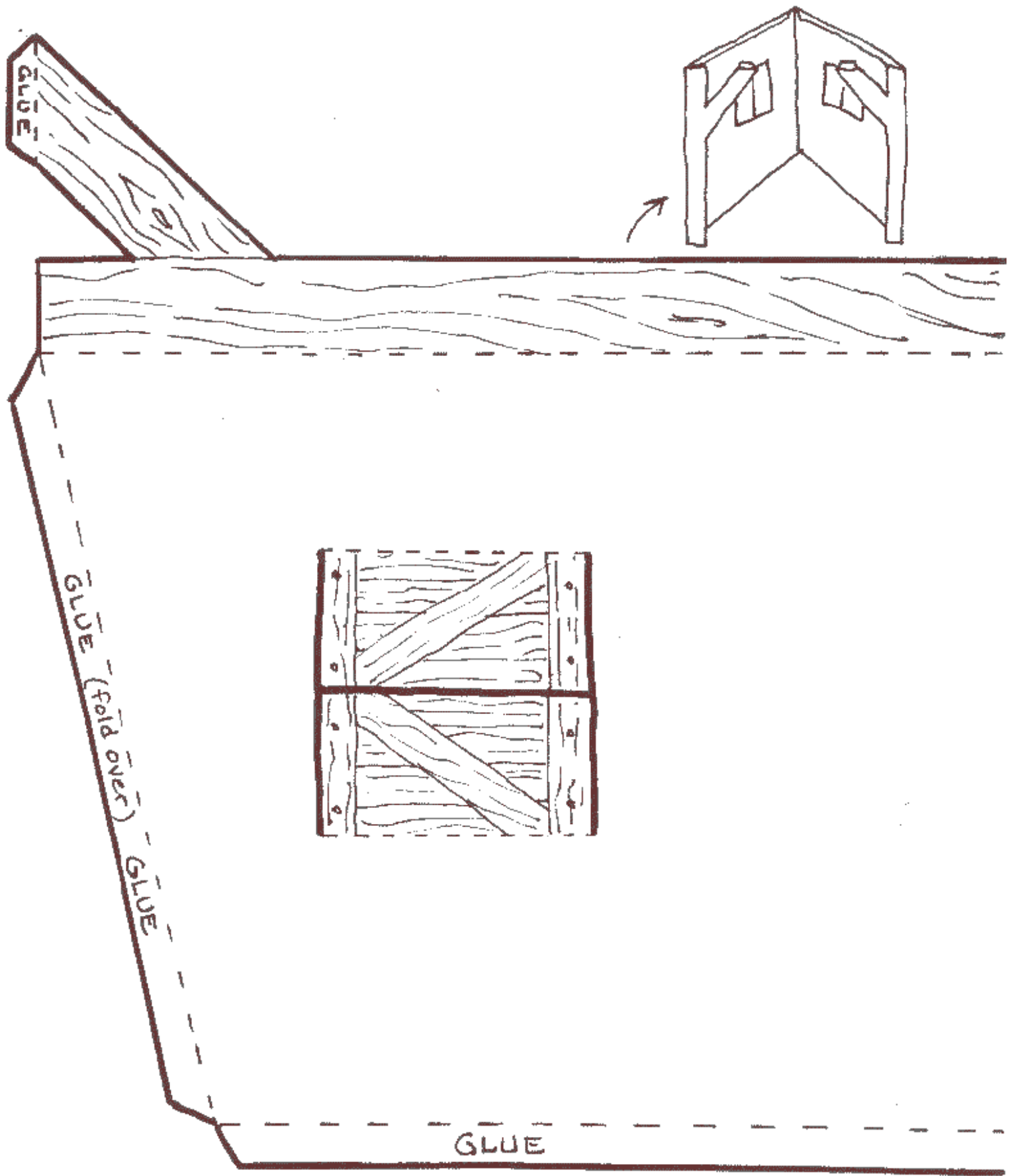
Stable Roof
