If by chance you see fine black lines across the graphics, do not worry, they will not print. It is caused by a conflict with some video monitor's drivers. You can make them go away by reducing or enlarging the size on your screen under "View" on your menu bar.

Now you can print as many copies of each page as you want when you need them.

Just remember to specify which page or pages you want to print in the 'Print Dialog Box' or by default the whole set will print. Example: To print page 8, enter "Print page 8 to 8".

To get the largest prints possible, change the default size setting using the drop-down list from "Layout, Fit to Page" to "100%". You can print all sorts of smaller sizes by entering a smaller percentage too.

For best results use heavy weight paper like index, card stock or cover weight.

For best results, set your printer to the "High Quality" setting.

To really save money on inkjet ink you can refill your own cartridges. Now refill kits are available at office supply stores, but to REALLY save, order kits from an independent supplier like Mister Ink Jet. www.MisterInkJet.com Their kits refill something like 25 times. My experience is that the generic cartridges take more refills than the brand name ones too. Just be sure to refill before you run completely out of ink, run a head cleaning cycle or two after you refill & remove the cellophane tape you might put on while refilling, if your cartridges have openings on the bottom, before you replace them in your printer.
